

Pulaski/Richland Comprehensive Plan Review Committee
Meeting June 2, 2022

The meeting was called to order by chairperson, Dawn Holynski at 6:02pm.

Minutes: The minutes of the May 5, 2022 were not presented for approval; therefore, will present at the August meeting.

Conservation Subdivision Design (CSD):

A meeting had been planned with Jeanie Gleisner to help a group of key people from the Village and Town boards, planning and zoning members to understand what a CSD is and how it would benefit the Village and Township. Included in this meeting would be a site visit to a parcel of land that could be sought out by residential developers and the importance of conserving the land instead of the “cookie cutter” designs currently used. The May 25th date was not suitable to the majority who was asked to attend. Jeanie and the landowners are agreeable to a date later in the summer.

Salmon River Corridor – Trails:

A publication of a research project by SUNY ESF students was given to Jan Tighe a few months ago from Dave Turner, Oswego County Community Development and Tourism, and loaned to Dawn to see if this information is or should be added to the current Comprehensive Plan. The Plan makes reference about trails but not to the extent this publication does. This publication discusses extending the trails along the entire way of the river, extending into the other townships.

Dawn commented that the goals and recommendations updates already completed and voted upon by the Village and Town, has taken more years to update than the original Plan took to create.

Dawn made a motion to have the Comp Plan Review Committee review the publication and recommend changes at a later time. The motion was seconded by Donna. All in favor. None opposed.

It has been decided not to hold a July meeting. The next meeting will be held August 4, 2022.

Meeting ended at 7:10 p.m. with a motion by Donna Gilson and seconded by Melissa Wadkinson. All in favor, motion passed.
